PASTOR’S NOTE

Next weekend at all the liturgies we will celebrate the feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the patron saint of our parish. We will hold a reception in the Fr. Polk Social hall after each liturgy, including the 5:30pm vigil mass. I hope you can join us!

During the week of July 11-16, six of our teenagers attended the Catholic sponsored “Encounter” Workcamp in Prince Georges County. They worked at various sites: visiting children in a hospital; helping senior citizens in their homes; working at a soup kitchen; and sharing their gift of music. The three hundred young people who participated began their day with Mass at 7:30am. On Wednesday I visited with them at the University of Maryland, College Park where they were staying. A Reconciliation Service was held that evening.

I thank our young people for their participation in the Workcamp. Thanks also to Carol Smith, our Coordinator of Faith Formation and Youth Ministry for accompanying our young people.

Planning continues for the Dedication Mass for our new Multi-Purpose Building on Sunday, September 19th and for moving into the building. Furniture and equipment has been ordered and will be delivered after Labor Day. We are going to need help to put together tables and unpack chairs from boxes and move furnishings from the Fr. The tables, chairs and audio-visual equipment have been ordered, costing some \$32,000 delivered. At this time we are raising monies to purchase what we have ordered. First Eucharist & Reconciliation
