PASTOR'S NOTE

Over a decade ago the Archdiocese of Baltimore and the Diocese of Gonaives in Haiti became sister dioceses. A number of parishes in our Archdiocese, including St. Anne, Hagerstown and St. Timothy, Walkersville have formed sister parish relationships with parishes in Haiti. This past spring our Parish Council decided to form a sister parish relationship with Immaculate Conception Parish in Villard, Haiti. Over the past couple of months a steering committee of our parishioners has been laying the foundation for our parish's participation.

As I announced last week at Mass, Fr. Charles Faubert, the pastor of Immaculate Conception parish in Haiti, will be visiting us here at St. Ignatius the weekend of September 11 and 12th. Fr. Faubert will concelebrate with me at all four masses next weekend. We will have a reception for his parish after each mass under a tent outside because the furniture for the new Multi-Purpose Building will probably still be in the Fr. Polk Social Hall. At the conclusion of each Mass an offering for Immaculate Conception will be taken up at the front doors of the Church. If you would like to make a donation by using a check, please make the check out to St. Ignatius and we will forward your gift in full to Fr. Faubert.

I look forward to meeting Fr. Faubert again! He was here a little over two years ago speaking to members of our Seniors Group. At that time, Fr. Faubert was pastor of another Haitian Parish. I am very excited at this new opportunity for sharing faith between our two parishes!

Just a reminder – Archbishop O'Brien will be here to celebrate the 12:00noon Mass on Sunday, September 19th. After the liturgy, the Archbishop will bless and dedicate our Multi-Purpose Building. I share with you that we will be using incense during the liturgy and dedication.
